### Interested in Knowing More about Becoming Catholic?

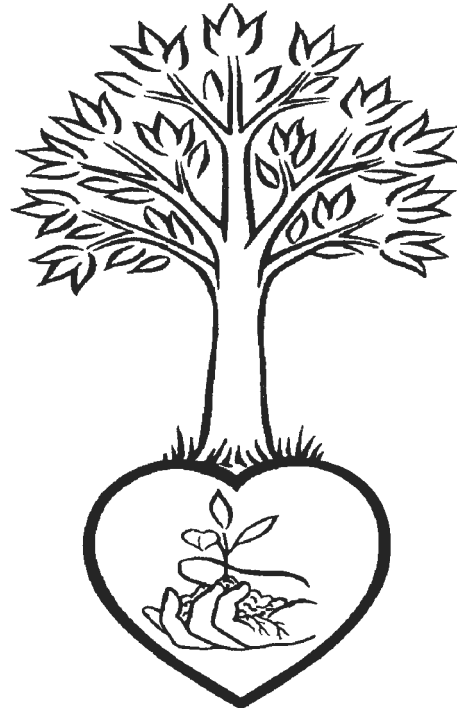
